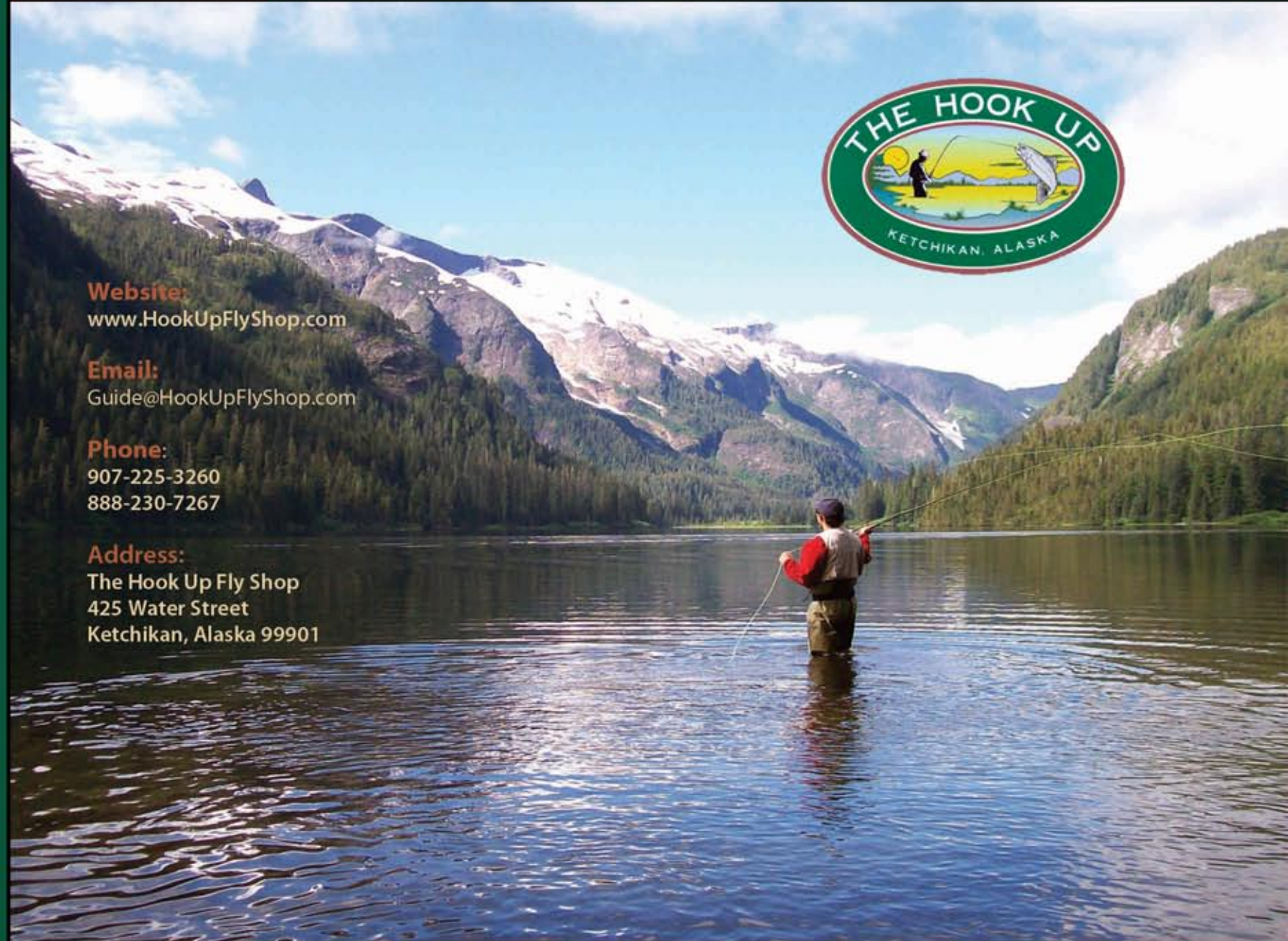

FLY-FISHING IN KETCHIKAN, ALASKA

Salmon, Trout and Steelhead

From Spring until Autumn, anglers will have excellent chances at tying into a variety of highly-prized sport fish. **Five species of Pacific Salmon** (Chinook, Coho, Chum, Sockeye and Pink), begin their annual migration upstream from **July - October**. Grown strong on the ocean's bounty, hooking into one of these bruisers will test any fisherman's mettle. Our area's prolific salmon runs are truly one of nature's most spectacular displays, and attract Alaska's impressive wildlife, such as **bears, eagles and seals**, among others.

From **March - May**, robust runs of **wild steelhead** enter the area's many rivers & streams. One of the most coveted species on a fly rod, few places in the world can boast the **outstanding catch rate** for steelhead (averaging 8-12 lbs) found here in SE Alaska.

Native **rainbow and cutthroat trout**, in addition to **dolly varden**, are available throughout the season in excellent numbers, and often provide superb **dry fly action**.

Road System Trips

We offer full day or half day (4 hrs) excursions to an incredibly productive stream just outside of town for salmon, trout and steelhead. **Conveniently located only 8 miles from our shop**, it's a perfect option for those with limited time who need to get back to their cruise ship for departure. And when the salmon are in, your arms will likely be so beat that 3 or 4 hours will be more than enough action! **Don't miss out, you can be off the ship and catching fish within a few short minutes!**

Fly Out Fishing / Flightseeing Combo

One of the most unforgettable fishing excursions imaginable, we offer fly out fishing trips to incredibly wild and remote destinations only a short flight from Ketchikan. Far from the trappings of civilization, you will encounter all manner of wildlife (bears, eagles, marine mammals, etc.) deep within the heart of **Tongass National Forest** (17 million acres), or inside the world-renowned **Misty Fjords National Monument** (2.5 million acres). Of course the fishing is incredible, but half the fun is just getting there, all while taking in what is arguably Alaska's most superlative scenery. **Half day, full day or overnight trips** can be arranged upon request.

Rates

Our Guides are licensed professionals certified in CPR and First Aid, who will ensure you have an amazing and safe trip. We pride ourselves in the personalized attention and instruction we give to every guest, and prefer to limit our outings to at most 2 or 3 clients per guide. The use of top of the line waders, boots, rods, reels, lines and flies is all included.

- **Road Trips:** \$250 for a 4 hour excursion, \$30 each additional hour (based on double occupancy)

- **Fly Outs:** \$200 per person for a 4 hour excursion, plus cost of floatplane charter
\$300 for a full day, plus the cost of the floatplane charter

*Floatplane charters run between \$575 - \$1000 depending on the distance to destination, which is split evenly between all passengers. For example, 4 anglers wishing to do a full day fly out on a charter costing \$800, the per person cost would be $(\$800 \div 4 = 200) + (\$300 \text{ guide fee}) = \500
